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## Deliverable Information

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## About the Level Up project

Empowering and modernising the way in which SMEs and labor workforce in general operate is an imperative need and priority across EU. Now, more than ever, SMEs need to follow the latest technological developments and become digitally transformed, otherwise they cannot survive nor compete in the highly competitive workplace. Providing the possibility to the current workforce to access industry-oriented and current training reflecting the latest developments in key ICT capacity areas, is essential towards achieving the digital transformation of the labor workforce.

Level Up aims to empower the labor force of European SMEs in digital competencies, through the development and provision of short-term training courses focusing on the following key capacity areas: Cybersecurity, Data Literacy, Data Analytics, Artificial Intelligence, microelectronics/microcontrollers, Internet of Things, 3D printing and 3D modelling, cloud and programming. Seven renowned training providers from Cyprus, Greece, Germany, Italy, and Finland have joined forces in order to co-design and deliver high quality industry-oriented training courses targeting SMEs and job seekers, with the support of seven business associations from Cyprus, Greece, Germany, Poland and Hungary, who will largely promote Level Up and its training courses to a large number of SMEs.

The consortium creates and delivers a new pool of training courses on the basis of the expertise knowledge and experience of the consortium training providers and account on the actual needs of the labor workforce. More than 100 training courses are created and also listed on the Digital Skills and Jobs Platform from the Level Up consortium, reaching out to an estimated number of 15000 participants from 3000 SMEs during the lifespan of the project.

## Executive Summary

This deliverable presents the full set of informative events and stakeholder-engagement activities implemented throughout the Level Up project, together with the organisation and outcomes of the Final Online Event. These activities formed the core of the project's dissemination and exploitation strategy, ensuring continuous visibility, broad outreach, and sustained engagement with key audiences across Europe.

Across the project's duration, the consortium implemented **56 informative events**, significantly surpassing the initial KPI target of 13 events. These activities were organised at local, national, and European levels, reaching SMEs, business associations, policymakers, research communities, digital skills stakeholders, educators, young professionals, and the wider public. The events included conferences, fairs, high-level policy meetings, scientific congresses, workshops, exhibitions, stakeholder roundtables, and specialised industry forums. Together, they provided multiple channels for presenting the Level Up training offer, strengthening stakeholder networks, and supporting the project's long-term visibility and impact.

A major highlight of this reporting period was the **Final Online Event**, held on 4 November 2025 and organised by the European University Cyprus with support from GrantXpert Consulting Ltd and the consortium. Delivered in hybrid format, the event gathered more than **400 participants** (300 onsite and 100+ online), showcasing the project's complete training catalogue, achievements, and exploitation potential. Featuring partner presentations and a keynote lecture by innovation expert Peter Hinssen, the event reinforced Level Up's contribution to Europe's digital transformation and future-skills agenda.

Throughout the implementation of these activities, partners demonstrated strong coordination, consistent effort, and extensive mobilisation of their regional and sectoral networks. Their contributions ensured that the project reached a wide and diverse audience and maintained high visibility across Europe's digital skills ecosystem.

Overall, the project significantly exceeded its dissemination KPIs, achieving **431% of the event-related target** and **200% of the final-event participation target**. These results reflect the consortium's commitment to maximising outreach and enabling broad uptake of Level Up's training offer. The

activities documented in this deliverable lay a strong foundation for the continued exploitation of the project's outcomes beyond its official end.

## Introduction

Informative events and stakeholder engagement activities played a central role in strengthening the visibility, uptake, and impact of the Level Up project throughout its implementation. By participating in and organising a broad range of events across Europe—spanning conferences, fairs, roundtables, scientific congresses, networking sessions, and high-level policy forums—the consortium ensured continuous outreach to key audiences and positioned Level Up as a relevant contributor to Europe’s digital upskilling ecosystem.

These events served as a strategic channel for presenting the project’s objectives, promoting the training catalogue, and fostering dialogue with diverse stakeholders. Engagement reached a wide spectrum of target groups, including SMEs, industry representatives, scientific and research communities, policymakers, educators, young professionals, national coalitions, digital skills organisations, and innovation clusters. Through these interactions, the project aimed not only to disseminate information but also to understand market needs, support skills development, and encourage participation in the training courses.

The activities described in this deliverable also contribute to Level Up’s sustainability strategy. By creating visibility at regional, national, and European levels, the consortium enhanced the project’s potential for long-term uptake, collaboration, and integration into existing and future initiatives. The culmination of these efforts was the final online event, which showcased the project’s full results and reinforced the value of its training offer for the digital transformation of European SMEs and the wider labour market.

This deliverable is structured to provide both a comprehensive overview and an in-depth analysis of the project’s outreach and dissemination activities. ### Attendance at the Final Online Event

- **Actual achievement:** **400+ participants in total**
  - **300 onsite** participants
  - **100+ online** attendees
- **Achievement rate:** **200% of the target.**

The event substantially exceeded the KPI, doubling the expected attendance. Beyond the numerical success, the **composition of the audience** strongly aligned with the intent of the KPI: to engage the



actors most relevant for disseminating, reusing, and exploiting the project's results. Participants included:

- SME owners and managers
- Business professionals
- Policymakers and public sector representatives
- University staff, students, and researchers
- Training providers and digital skills organisations

The hybrid format proved highly effective in ensuring accessibility for both local and international participants. Engagement during the keynote speech, training course showcases, and partner presentations was high, and participant feedback confirmed the value, applicability, and relevance of the Level Up training offer.

The event not only exceeded the quantitative KPI but fully achieved its qualitative purpose: showcasing Level Up's outcomes to influential stakeholders capable of sustaining, promoting, and integrating the project's results into their ecosystems.

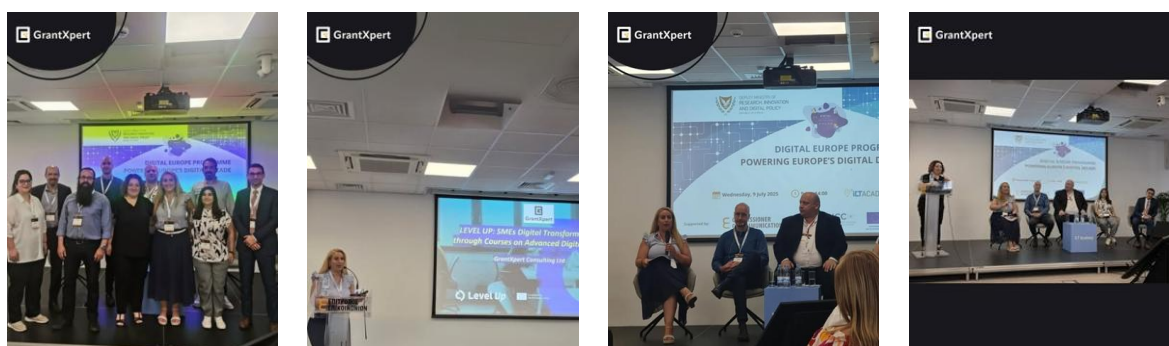

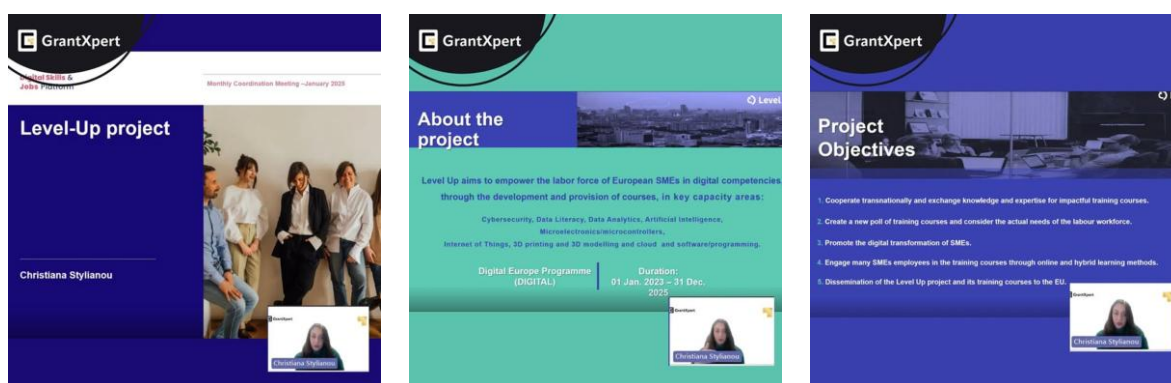

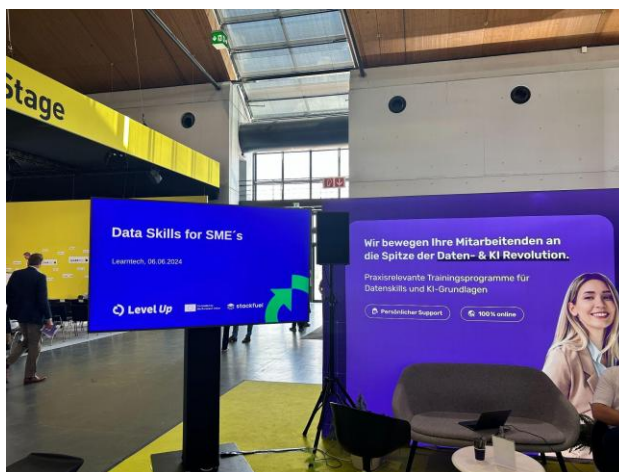

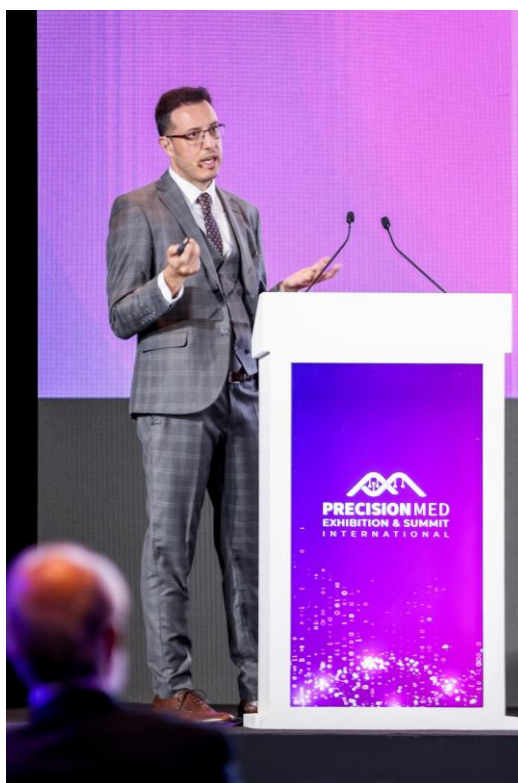

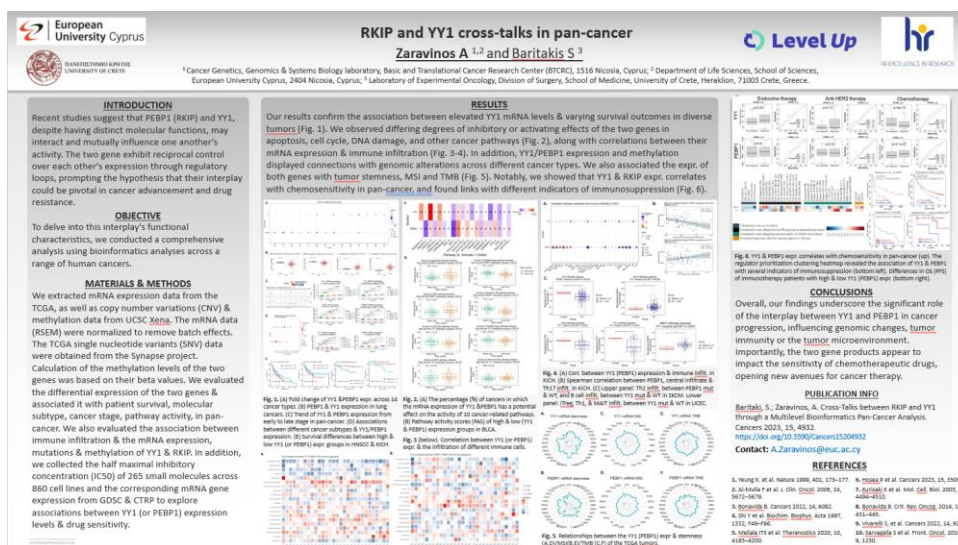

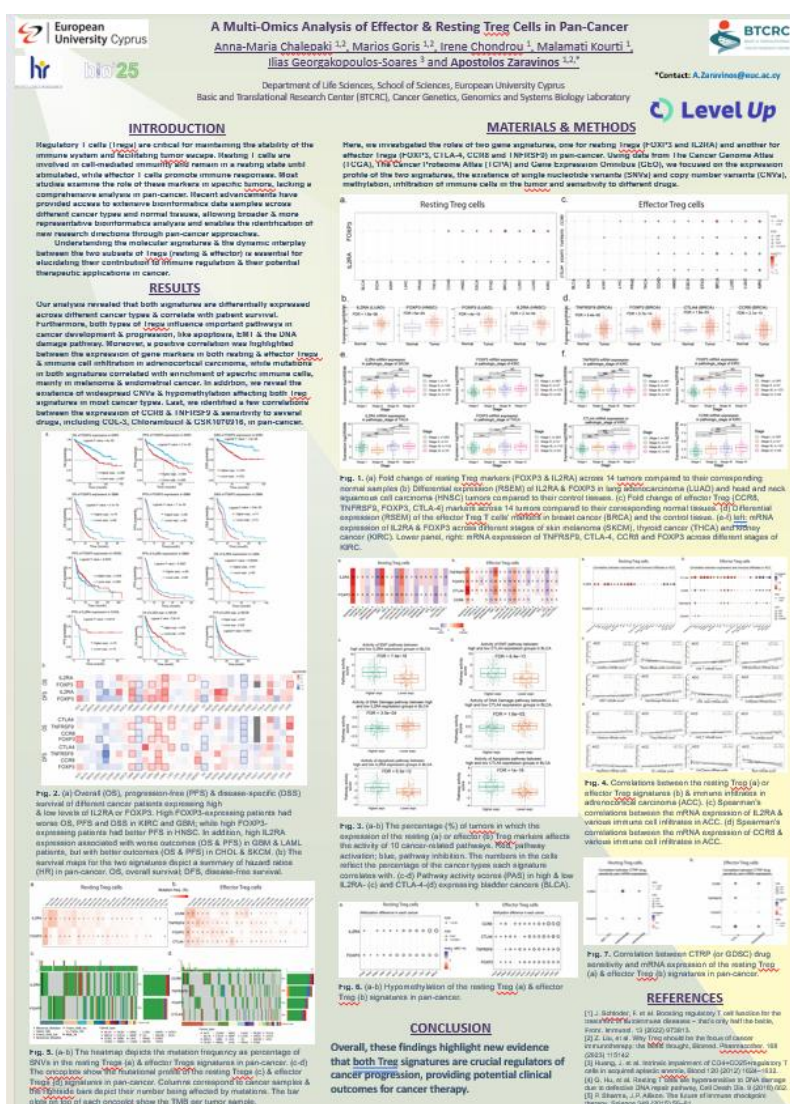

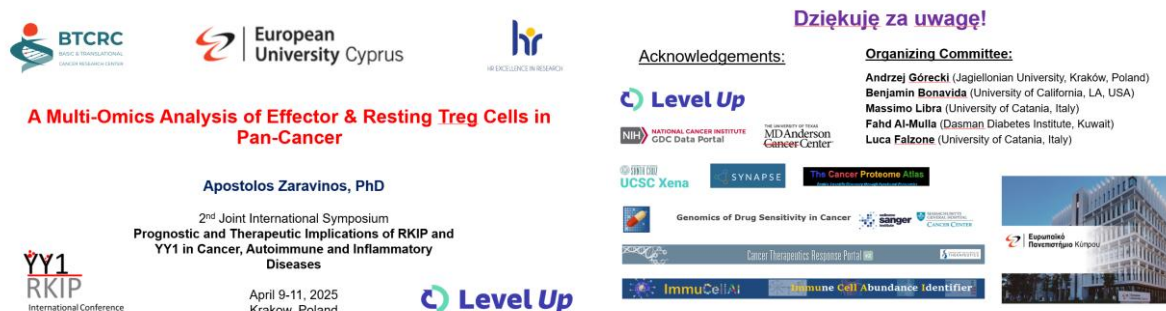

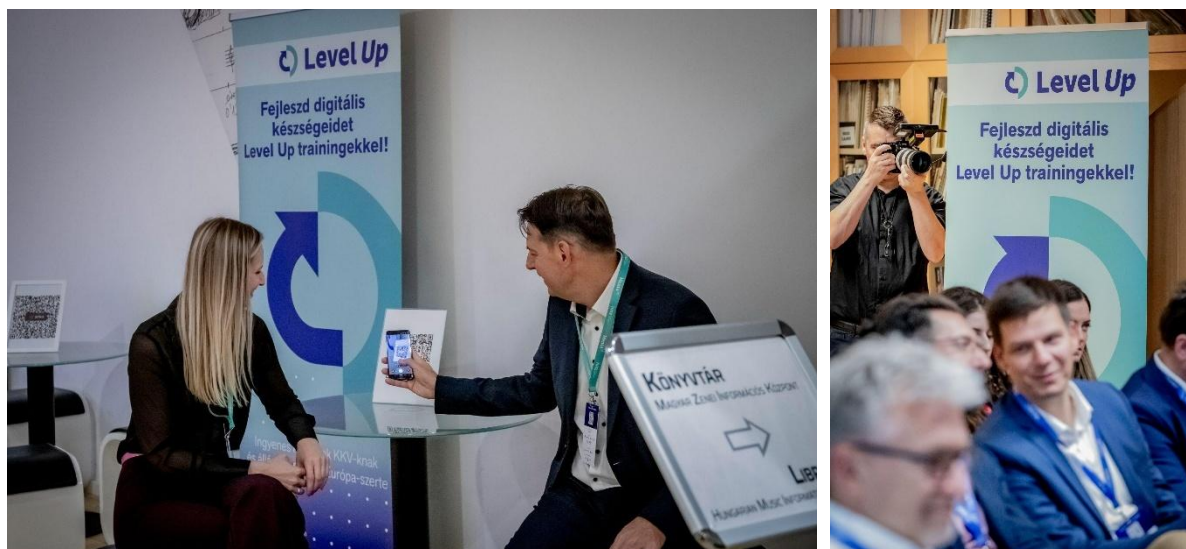

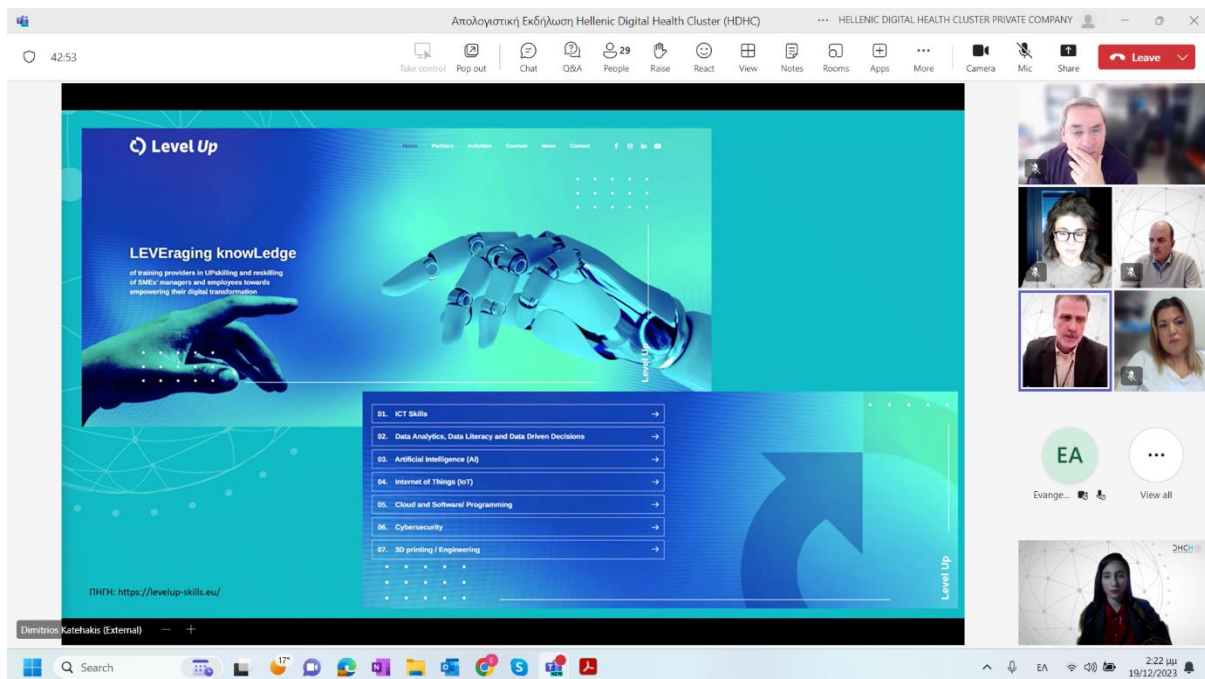
**Figure 33: The Hellenic Digital Health Cluster presenting the Level Up project during the Innodays Conference 2023 in Heraklion, Crete.**

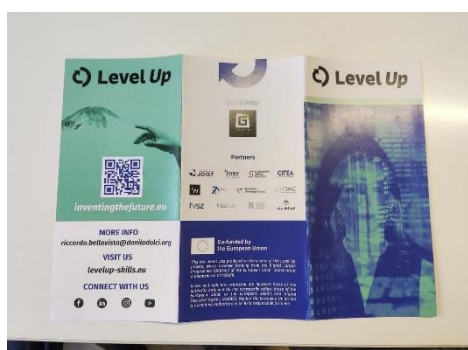

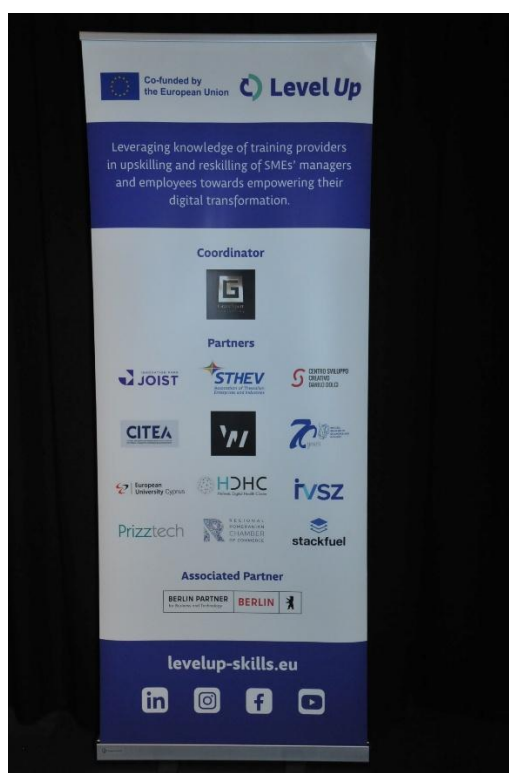

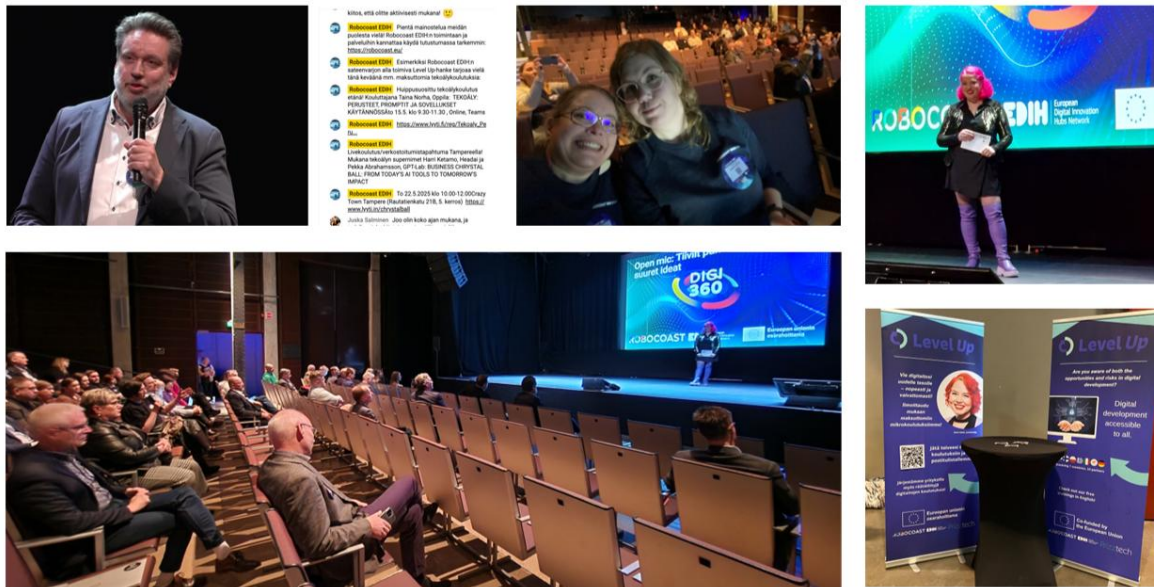


Figure 54: Robocoast EDIH showcasing the Level Up project at the DIGI360 Conference in Turku, Finland.

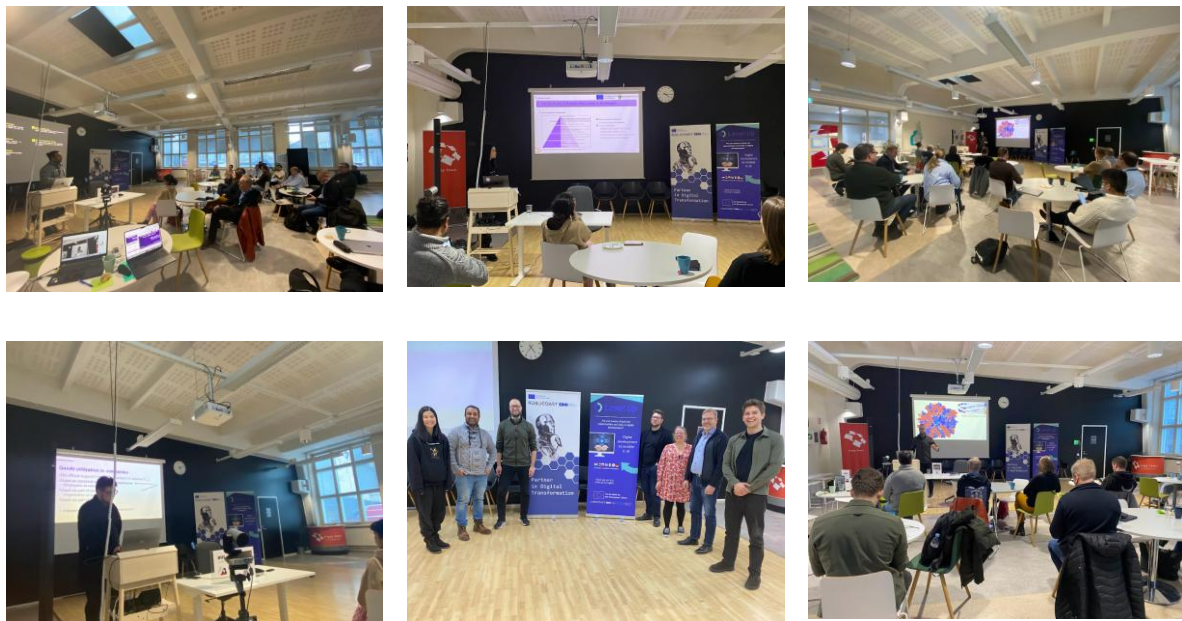

## Purpose and Scope

The final event of the Level Up project was organised by **European University Cyprus (EUC)**, with the strategic support of **GrantXpert Consulting Ltd (GX)** and the active participation of all partner organisations. The purpose of the event was to **disseminate the project's main outputs**, with particular emphasis on the **training courses** developed and implemented across the consortium. A key highlight of the event was the **exclusive keynote lecture by world-renowned innovation expert Peter Hinssen**, titled “*How to Leverage Innovation and Digital Technologies in an Age of Uncertainty*”. His presentation captivated the audience with insights drawn from collaborations with leading global companies such as Google, Amazon, Microsoft, and Apple, inspiring participants to view uncertainty as a driver of creativity and growth.

## Duration and Structure

The event lasted 3 hours and featured the following components:

- **Opening session and welcome address** by **Celia Hadjichristodoulou**, Project Coordinator (GrantXpert Consulting Ltd), presenting an overview of the project, KPIs, and partner contributions.
- **Showcase of the Level Up training courses**, where each partner introduced the courses implemented and shared best practices and success stories.
- **Video presentation** summarising the project’s key results, milestones, and impact ([available here](#)).
- **Keynote session by Peter Hinssen**, organised under the *Future Skills Hub* of EUC and within the *AI Awareness Month* framework.
- **Networking and closing cocktail reception**, offering participants the opportunity to connect and discuss future collaborations.

## Target Groups and Promotion

The event targeted a wide range of participants, including:

- Business leaders, managers, and employees
- Job seekers and young professionals
- Business and technology associations
- Policy makers and public institutions

- HRDA representatives and training providers
- HR managers and university alumni officers

Promotion of the event was carried out through:

- The official websites and social media channels of EUC, GX, and partner organisations
- Direct invitations to national and European stakeholders
- Press releases and digital campaigns
- Streaming via EUC's YouTube channel to maximise reach and visibility

## KPIs and Attendance

The event achieved a **total attendance of over 400 participants**, comprising:

- **300 participants onsite** at the European University Cyprus Cultural Centre
- **More than 100 online viewers** via live YouTube broadcasting

Participants represented a diverse range of **sectors** including education, ICT, business development, innovation, and digital transformation, as well as **geographical diversity** across Europe.

## Photos and Highlights

The event was a major highlight of the project's dissemination activities, combining expert insights, partner presentations, and live demonstrations of the training courses.

Visual material from the event, including photos and video excerpts, are available on the **Level Up project's website** and **EUC's social media channels**.

The evening concluded with a **networking cocktail reception**, fostering dialogue and collaboration among professionals, students, and industry leaders.

## Feedback and Outcomes

Feedback from participants was highly positive. Attendees commended the **quality and relevance** of the project's training courses and expressed strong interest in future access and participation.

The keynote by Peter Hinssen received particular acclaim for its **inspirational and forward-looking message**, positioning the Level Up project within the broader context of digital innovation and future skills development.

## Lessons Learned and Suggestions

The hybrid event format proved highly effective in **maximising outreach and inclusivity**, allowing both local and international audiences to engage.

For future events, the consortium suggests:

- Expanding simultaneous translation options to engage a wider non-English-speaking audience
- Incorporating more interactive sessions, such as live Q&As or virtual workshops, to enhance participant engagement
- Continuing collaboration with innovation leaders to maintain the momentum of digital skills promotion beyond the project's lifetime

## Potential Follow-Up Opportunities

The event generated significant momentum for further exploitation of Level Up outputs. Potential follow-up actions include:

- Continued promotion of the **Level Up courses through EUC's Future Skills Hub**
- Integration of selected courses into **lifelong learning and professional development programmes**
- Establishment of new **collaborations with industry and education stakeholders** to sustain project results.

The event successfully reinforced Level Up's legacy as a **pan-European initiative promoting digital skills and employability**, setting the foundation for ongoing collaboration and impact beyond the project's official end.

## Final Conclusions and Performance Review

### Achievement Summary

The Level Up consortium implemented a wide and diverse set of informative events throughout the duration of the project. Against the initial KPI target of **13 informative events**, the consortium delivered a total of **56 events**, achieving **431% of the original KPI**.

This significant overperformance reflects the strong commitment of all partners to maximise the project's outreach, visibility, and stakeholder engagement at local, national, and European levels.

In addition to the informative events, the project successfully delivered its **Final Online Event**, which served as the flagship dissemination and exploitation activity showcasing the project's outcomes, training catalogue, and impact.

#### Final Event Attendance vs. KPI

The final event also exceeded expectations:

- **KPI target:** 200 participants
- **Actual attendance:** 400+ participants
- **Achievement rate:** 200%

The participation included more than 300 onsite attendees at European University Cyprus and over 100 online viewers, demonstrating strong interest from academia, businesses, policy stakeholders, digital skills communities, and young professionals.

### Lessons Learned

#### Stakeholder Engagement Outcomes

The broad geographical coverage and strong partner networks proved instrumental in engaging SMEs, business associations, scientific communities, policymakers, and educators. Key outcomes include:

- Reinforced stakeholder interest in reusing Level Up training materials.

- Increased visibility within EU-level communities (e.g., DSJP, National Coalitions, EDIHs).
- Strengthened connections between industry and academia, especially through scientific and innovation conferences.

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## What Worked Well

The implementation of the informative events and the final dissemination activities generated valuable insights into the consortium's outreach strategy, communication effectiveness, and engagement with key stakeholder groups. Several strengths clearly emerged throughout the project, contributing substantially to the successful promotion and uptake of Level Up's training offer. In particular, the following aspects proved especially effective in maximising visibility, participation, and overall project impact:

- **Extensive partner mobilisation**, enabling outreach across multiple countries and sectors.
- **Participation in high-profile summits and conferences**, boosting EU-level visibility.
- **Use of hybrid and online formats**, which significantly expanded the project's reach.
- **Clear and accessible messaging** about free, high-quality digital training for SMEs.
- The **keynote by Peter Hinssen** enhanced credibility and attracted new stakeholders.

## Impact of the Events

The informative and final dissemination events delivered under Task 2.5 and 2.6 not only exceeded the project's quantitative targets but also generated substantial scientific, economic, societal, and industrial impact across Europe. With **a total of 56 events**—including **11 scientific conferences**, more than **20 industry-focused forums and business events**, several SME-targeted workshops, and multiple public and youth-oriented activities—the consortium ensured broad outreach, knowledge transfer, and stakeholder engagement. The diversity of events enabled Level Up to contribute to digital transformation across sectors while reinforcing the project's role as a pan-European catalyst for advanced digital skills.

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## Scientific Impact

Participation in **11 international scientific conferences and symposia** (FEBS, ESHG, EUROTOX, EACR, Bio3 Forum, PMES, etc.) amplified the visibility of Level Up within the research community. Presentations and posters acknowledging Level Up fostered dialogue on AI, multi-omics, bioinformatics, precision medicine, and emerging digital technologies. These engagements strengthened academic collaboration and highlighted the contribution of digital skills to scientific innovation.

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## Economic Impact

More than **30 events** targeting SMEs, business associations, chambers, and enterprises contributed to improved digital readiness and competitiveness across the European SME ecosystem. By promoting the free Level Up training courses, the events supported SMEs in reducing training costs, increasing operational efficiency, and strengthening their capacity for digital adoption—particularly in AI, cybersecurity, cloud technologies, and data analytics.

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## Societal Impact

Public-facing events such as the 4th Youth Festival, DYPA sessions, and stakeholder roundtables engaged young people, jobseekers, students, and the general public, promoting digital inclusion and equal access to upskilling opportunities. These activities helped raise awareness of the importance of digital competences for employability and empowered individuals to participate in Europe's digital transformation.

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## Industrial Impact

Across **more than 20 industrial events**, including hydrogen-energy conferences, transport and logistics forums, digital health events, and manufacturing-related meetings, Level Up reached key industrial stakeholders and reinforced the need for digital upskilling in sectors facing rapid technological change. The events facilitated cross-sector cooperation, encouraged industry engagement in training initiatives, and stimulated dialogue on emerging technologies, regulatory requirements, and workforce needs.

## Exploitation Outlook

### Role of the Final Event in Boosting Course Visibility

The final event substantially reinforced the exploitation potential of Level Up results by:

- Presenting the complete catalogue of training courses to a wide and influential audience.
- Demonstrating the project's long-term relevance for SMEs' digital transformation.
- Attracting new stakeholders interested in adopting the training offer.
- Positioning Level Up within the broader European agenda on digital skills and future workforce needs.

### Suggestions for Post-Project Visibility Actions

To ensure sustainability and long-term impact, the consortium recommends:

1. **Continued promotion of Level Up courses** through partner websites, newsletters, and social media channels.
2. **Integration of courses into existing training frameworks**, such as lifelong learning centres or company training programmes.
3. **Leveraging European networks** (EDIHs, clusters, chambers, DSJP) for long-term dissemination.
4. **Using Level Up materials in future EU project proposals** to ensure continuity and scaling.

5. **Organising follow-up showcases or webinars** to keep stakeholders engaged beyond the project's end.
6. **Aligning course promotion with major EU initiatives**, such as AI Awareness Month, European Cybersecurity Month, Data Week, and SME Week.
7. **Encouraging training providers to maintain updated versions** of selected courses beyond the project lifecycle.
